

### A BILL

To promote remediation of abandoned hardrock mines, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Good Samaritan Reme-
- 5 diation of Abandoned Hardrock Mines Act of 2022".

- 18 bipartisan co-sponsors
- Diverse groundswell of support
- Senate hearing in EPW



### Pilot Program Components



- 7 year/15 project pilot
- Limited liability relief
- Low risk projects
- Do no harm
- Robust public process
- Investigative sampling
- Landowner (i.e., cooperating person) participation
- Mining activities explicitly prohibited
- No profit-motive reprocessing
- Only remediation activities covered



### 118th Congress



- Leverage momentum and clear the legislative path.
- Desire from bill sponsors to be responsive to concerns.
- Legislation to be introduced in Senate \*soon\*.
- House companion bill.
- Move bill through committee and position for success.
- Legislative vehicles permitting reform?

## Hardrock AML Funding



- Funding and liability are twin challenges.
- \$3 billion authorized in IIJA sec. 40704.
- \$5 million appropriated in FY-23.
- \$30 million in President's FY-24 budget.
- \$3 million in House for FY-24 state grants.
- Need a paradigm shift.
