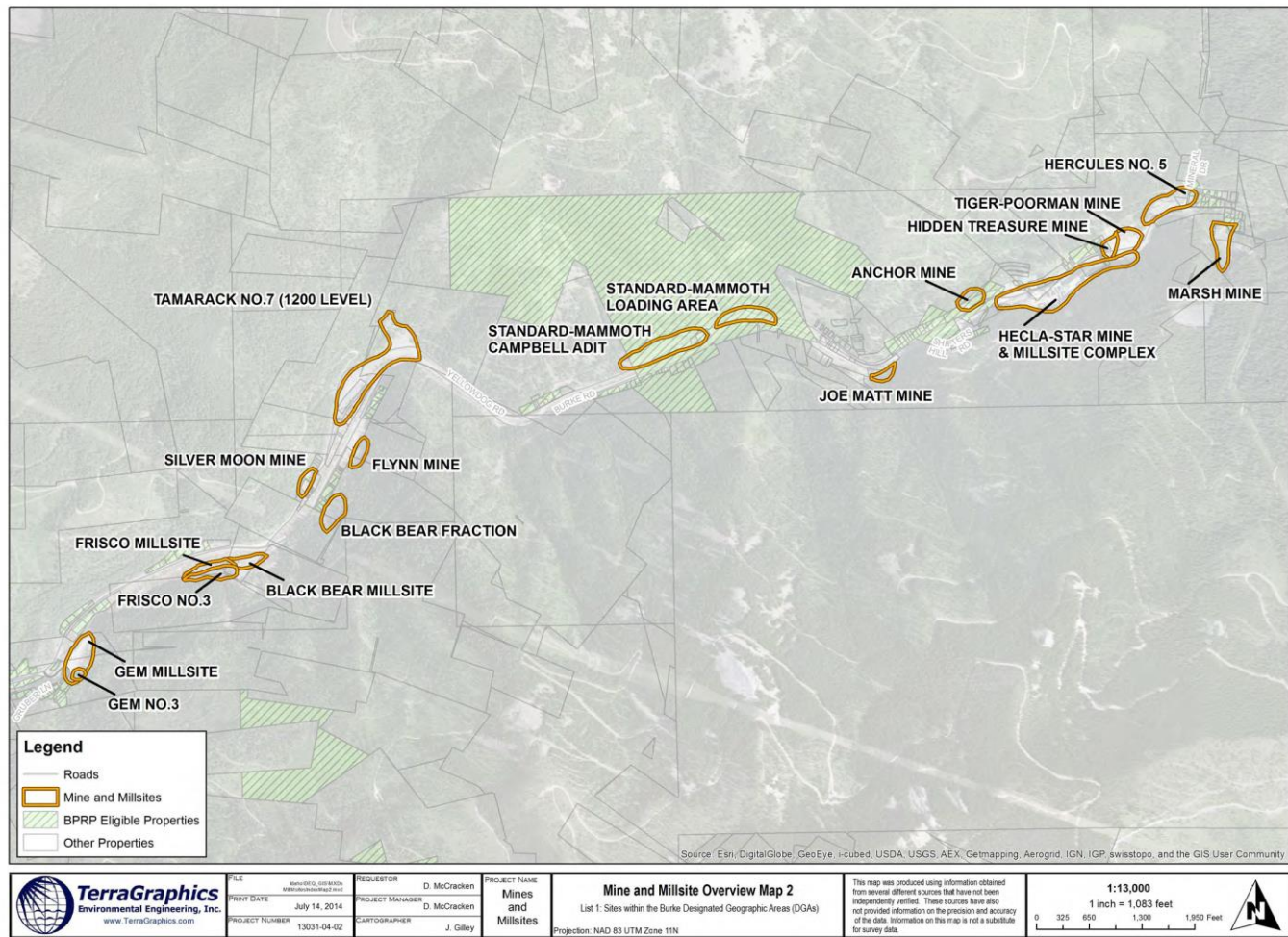

Canyon Creek Overview

- As a result of historical mining-related contamination, numerous mine and mill source sites and impacted riparian areas were identified for cleanup in the 2012 Record of Decision Amendment to reduce human health risks, reduce metals loading to surface water, and improve surface water quality.

Project overview

- Removal and disposal of 150,000 cy
- Reconstruction of 1500 lineal ft of creek channel
- Backfill and revegetate approx. 12 acres

Flooding December 2025



Tamarack No. 7

- Removal and disposal of 160,000 cy
- Reconstruction of 3000 lineal ft of creek channel
- Backfill and revegetate approx. 18 acres



Fynn Mine/Black Bear Fraction

- Removal and Disposal of 9000 cy
- Regrade, backfill, and revegetate approx. 9 acres
