





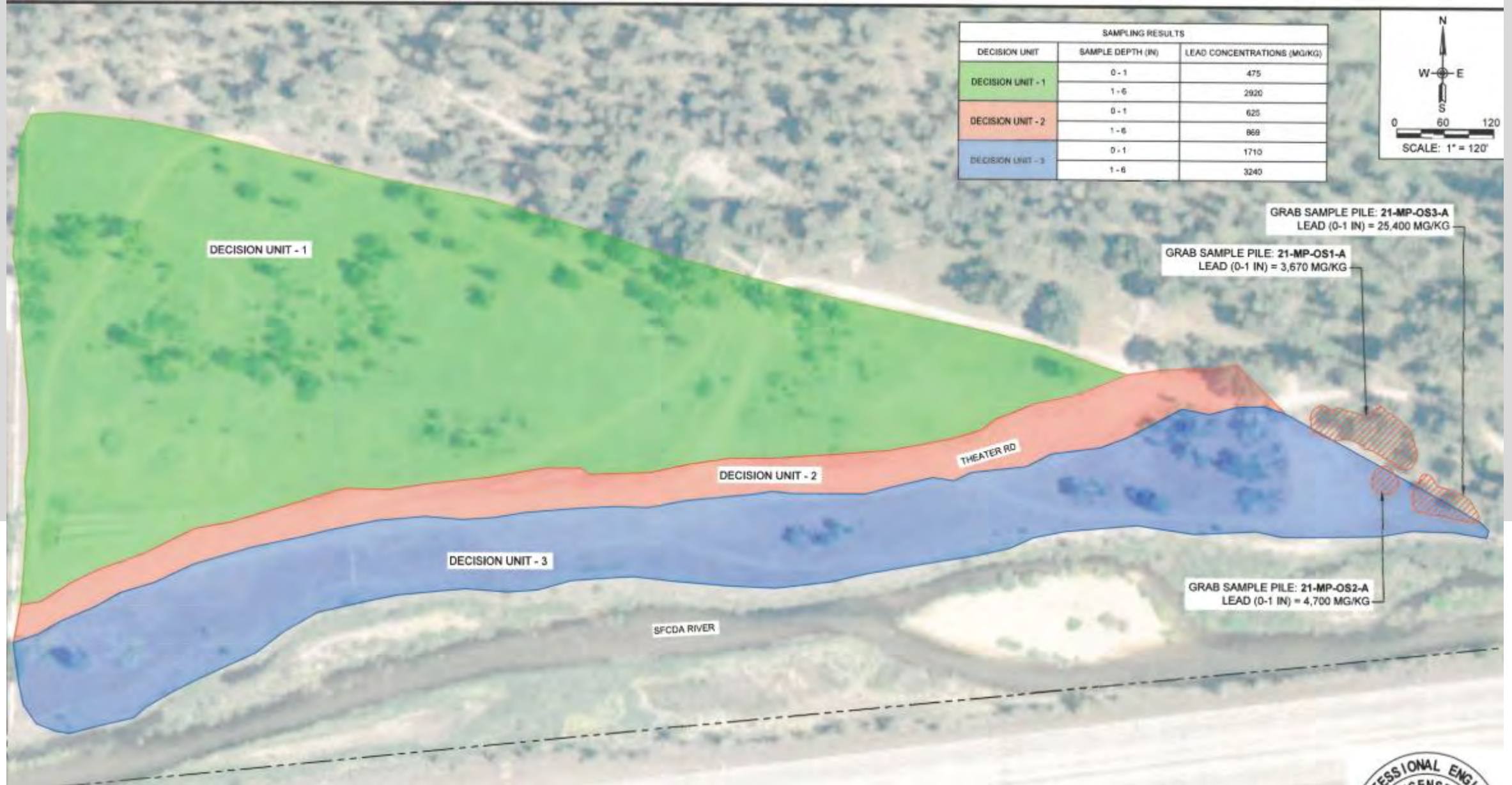
Uptown Kellogg Sidewalks Barriers

The sidewalks of the older uptown area were left in place during early remediation but were no longer functioning as an effective barrier to contamination. The project has replaced over 5,000LF to date, incorporated ADA standards and will continue this fall and next summer.



East Smelterville Flats Construction

Designed for recreational use and to serve as a city laydown area. This area incorporates walking trails, gated access to limit motorized vehicles and oasis pads for future picnic and resting benches. The area incorporated a 12" cap with barrier or 12" removal with barrier and cap constructed of either topsoil or gravel. The topsoil was vegetated with local field mix to reduce wind and water erosion. The area provides a safe place for dog walking, nature viewing and public gatherings.
